Wider Achievement

Recognising achievement is an integral element of Curriculum for Excellence. The Insight tool includes a wide range of awards and the Insight project team continues to facilitate the inclusion of wider achievement in the tool. However, there are many awards that are not included and cannot be included in Insight for technical or logistical reasons.

The inclusion of an award on Insight is not an indication of the value or importance of an award to individual learner journeys. Schools should continue to offer awards that are appropriate to their learners whether or not they are included in Insight.

Conditions for an award to be included in Insight

For any award to be included in Insight there are a number of conditions which must be met:

1. The award must be on the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF); once accredited the award is aligned with the SCQF framework and will be assigned an SCQF level as well as a SCQF Credit value

2. The award provider must use the same Scottish Candidate Number (SCN) as the school or 'base centre' when reporting attainment or achievement, so that each learner's attainment is appropriately assigned.
3. The award must align with the aims of Curriculum for Excellence, Scotland's curriculum framework.
4. The awards must conform to our technical requirements and data submission deadlines

Non-SQA award providers

We continue to work with new providers for future inclusion. We encourage schools to let us know who they are working with and encourage award providers to contact us at Insight@gov.scot to discuss inclusion of data on Insight. This contact should take place as early as possible in the school session to allow data sharing agreements to be put in place. **Please remember that awards must be on the SCQF to be included within Insight.**

Where are awards surfaced on Insight?

The majority of the awards in Insight are attained at the learner's base centre (the school where they have the most attainment), so are surfaced in Insight for that centre. Where learners are presented for an award out with their base centre (e.g. with a partner centre such as college / another award provider), attainment/tariff will be credited to the base centre in the National/Local dashboards and the Breadth and Depth measures. However, in the other local measures (graded and ungraded course measures and curricular area measures), attainment/tariff will be credited to the partner centre. This ensures that at a school level, the base centre gets credit for doing what is best for the learner but at a course level, the data reflects the performance of that course in the presenting centre.

For example-

If a learner at **School X** attains a course at **School Y** (such as a pupil studying an Advanced Higher at a neighbouring school) this attainment will appear for School X in the National/Local benchmarking measures, Breadth and Depth and the Partnership Course Summary. This attainment will appear for School Y for Local Course Measures, Curricular Areas, the Whole School and Selected Subject Summaries.

If a learner at **School X** attains a course at a **College** this attainment will appear for School X in the National/Local benchmarking measures, Breadth and Depth and the Partnership Course Summary. This attainment will not appear in the other Local Course Measures.
